User Manual - iPhone



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Introduction

EZ Software provides solutions for the day-to-day convenience of smartphone users.

EZ View is the first product of the line.

It aims at giving a superior experience in the use of the contacts list on the iPhone and iPod Touch.

Among other things it provides the option on the individual entries as well as on the lists to:

- change the font size
- choose a different font
- modify the background color
- specify your font color

This manual supplements the intuitive interface and shows the details of the operation of the application, should it become necessary.

Home screen

When the application is launched, the first screen that displays is the list of contacts.

Similar to the standard iPhone application, it gives you more display and sorting options, as described later.

The first time the application is started, the default will give a list sorted by first name, then by last name on a separate line.

Tapping a name will take you to one of three screens based on your selected option: Phone Numbers, Address or Email Address.

The list scrolls normally, in the traditional iPhone fashion. Tapping a letter on the right side will take you to the first entry with that initial.

Tapping the **AAA** and **AAA** icons respectively will increase and decrease the size of the font on this screen.

The  icon will take you to the Fonts Settings screen described later. Likewise, the  icon will bring up the Preferences screen described under its own section.

Phone Number Screen


This screen shows you the phone number(s) of the selected entry.

If the contact entry has more than one phone number, you can select the desired one by tapping the corresponding name above the number.

As on the Home Screen, you can adjust the font size by tapping the **AAA** and **AAA** icons.

In the bottom left corner of the screen you will see the  icon¹. Tapping it will call the currently selected number.

The three buttons at the bottom will take you to the Phone Number (currently active), Address and eMail Screens respectively.

¹ This icon and the corresponding feature will not be available on the iPod touch.

Address Screen

This screen shows you the address(es) of the selected entry.

If the contact entry has more than one address, you can select the desired one by tapping the corresponding name above the address.

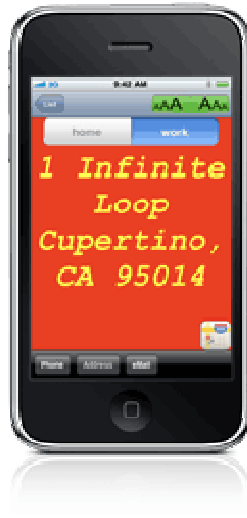



Figure 3 Address Screen

As on the Home Screen, you can adjust the font size by tapping the **AAA** and **AAA** icons.

In the bottom left corner of the screen you will see the  icon. Tapping it will bring up the address in the Maps application.

The three buttons at the bottom will take you to the Phone Number, Address (currently active) and eMail Screens respectively.



eMail Screen


This screen shows you the email address(es) of the selected entry.

If the contact entry has more than one email address, you can select the desired one by tapping the corresponding name above the address.

As on the Home Screen, you can adjust the font size by tapping the  and  icons.

In the bottom left corner of the screen you will see the  icon. Tapping it will start composing a new email message for the selected address.

The three buttons at the bottom will take you to the Phone Number, Address and eMail (currently active) Screens respectively.

Font Settings Screen

This screen has several controls.

Screen Selection

At the top a series of 4 segments lets you choose the screen to be configured:

- List (Home) Screen
- Phone Number
- Address
- Email

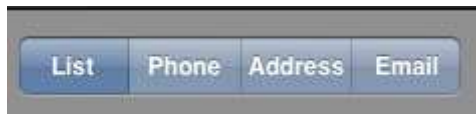


Figure 6 Screen Selection Segments

Any change made with the buttons on the corresponding screen will be reflected here.

The changes made in either place will “stick”, i.e. they will remain in effect every time you come back to the application.

Reset All Screens

Next to those 4 segments is a “Reset All” button.

Tapping this button will, after confirmation, reset all the font settings to their defaults.

List Line Selection

Once the screen is selected, all the other controls below will act on that particular section.

If the screen selected is the List screen, additional options will be available.

A switch lets you select whether the top and bottom line of the list should be the same.

If you choose them to be different, a pair of segments will let you specify which one you are currently configuring, top or bottom. If on the contrary you choose them to be the same, the “Top” and “Bottom” segments will disappear.

Font Size Adjustment

A slider lets you adjust the font size. The minimum and maximum can be different for different screens.

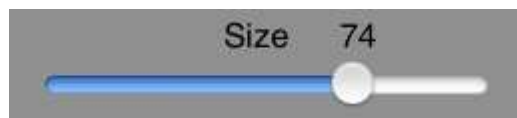


Figure 9 Font Size Slider

Reset One Screen

To the left of the slider a “Reset” button will reset the settings for the current screen to their default values.

Sample Display

Underneath, a sample of the selection appears with the font, the colors and the size chosen.

Font and Color Choice

But how do you bring in those fancy fonts and colors?

The two pickers below the sample are the secret.

TIP: You may find it sometimes difficult to move the pickers into view and instead find yourself turning the wheels. Or you want to pick a value and the screen moves instead.

The trick is simple:

- If you want to change the value on the wheels, hold your finger on the wheel just a short moment before starting to move. Alternatively, you can tap the value to bring in the selection.
- If on the contrary you just want to reposition the screen, just swipe quickly and the wheels will not budge. Once you started that sweeping movement, you can slow down and position the screen as precisely as you wish.

Font Picker

The top picker has two wheels. The left one chooses a font family, and the left one picks a font in the family. This is the font that will be used.

Some families have only one font, some have more.

Do not pay too much attention to the font names, they are there only if you want to recommend a choice to your friends, or remember yours.

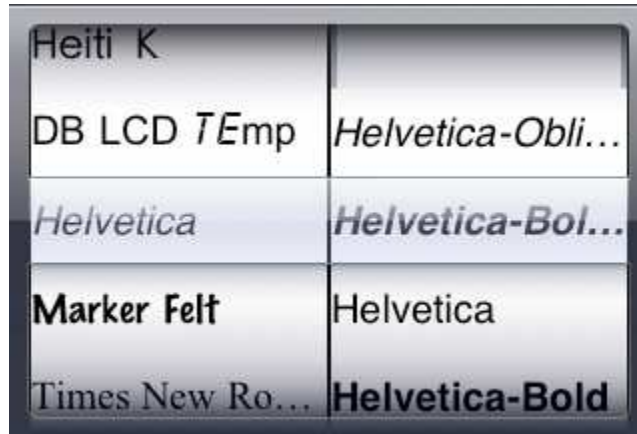


Figure 12 Font Picker

Color Picker

Then there is the color picker.

The left column is for the font color and the right column is for the background color.

To help you make your choice, the two wheels are synchronized: the font color chosen on the left will be set on the right and the background selected on the right will be used throughout the left roller.

Preferences Screen

This settings screen lets you adjust several options for EZ View. These settings will be remembered between uses of the application.

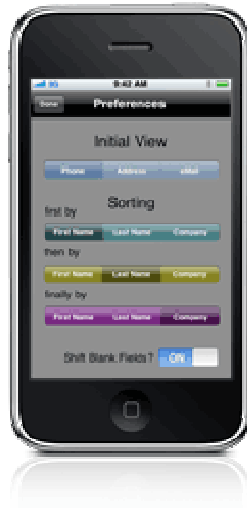


Figure 14 Other Settings Screen

Initial View

Here you choose which screen will be displayed when you tap a contact in the Home Screen. It is one of “Phone”, “Address” or “eMail”.

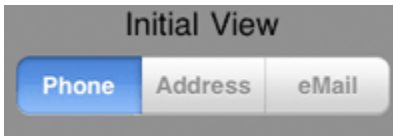


Figure 15 Initial View

Sorting

There are three criteria for you to sort on: First Name, Last Name and Company. The first 2 chosen will be displayed on the home screen. If there is a tie, the third field will decide the sequence.

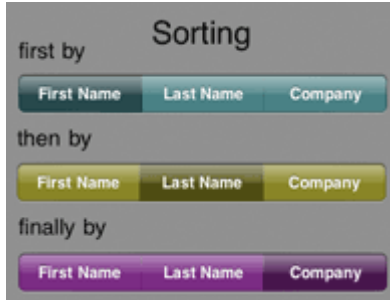


Figure 16 Sorting Options

Shift Blank Fields

Not all contacts have the three fields First Name, Last Name and Company.

If you turn on this option, any missing field will be replaced by the next one in the sort order. E.g. you have chosen the default sort order as above.

If a contact does not have a last name, the Home Screen will list the first name on the top line and the company on the bottom line. If you leave it off, the last name will simply be blank.

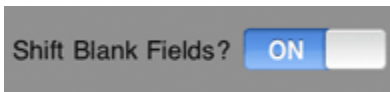


Figure 17 Shift Blank Fields
